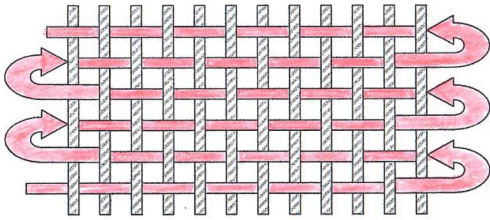
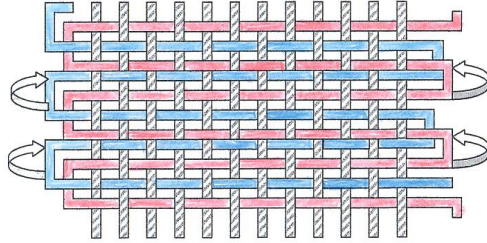

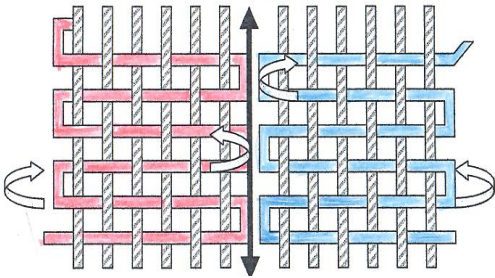
Plain Weave



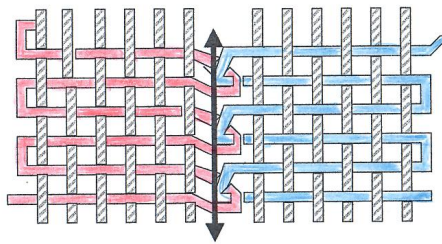
Basket weave /vertical strips



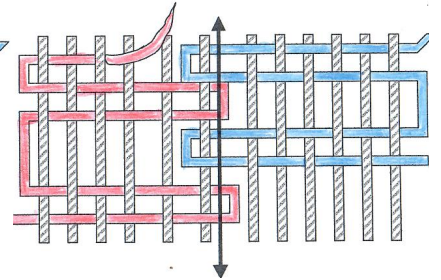
STRAIGHT SLIT



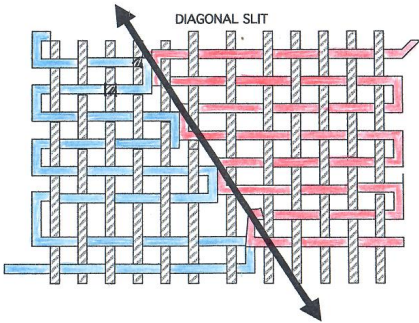
STRAIGHT INTERLOCK - COMMON WEFT



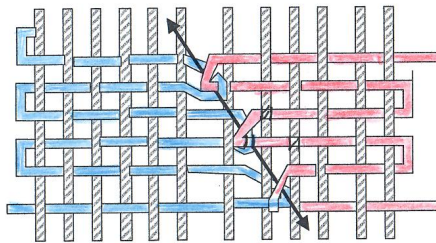
STRAIGHT INTERLOCK - COMMON WARP



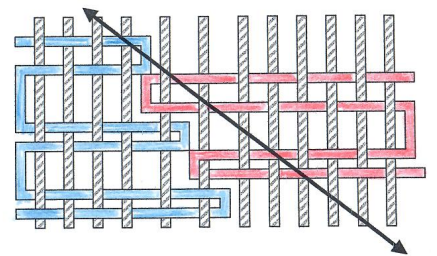
DIAGONAL SLIT



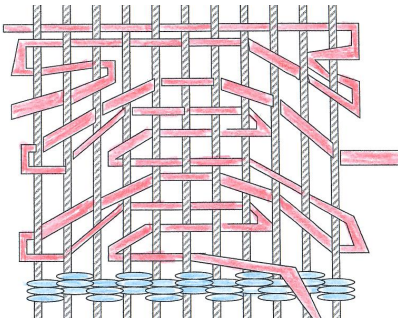
